

CHOICE ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

Applicants to grades K-8 can select up to 20 Choice programs on their GoCPS application. All Choice programs fill seats through a random computerized lottery; sibling preference is offered at all grade levels and staff preference is offered at the entry-level grade only. **New for the 2025-26 application cycle**, families will rank Elementary Choice programs in order of preference on the GoCPS application. Elementary applicants can receive one single best offer in the Choice category and will be automatically waitlisted for any programs ranked higher than the offer received. **Students are guaranteed a seat at their attendance area (neighborhood) school and families do not need to apply there through GoCPS.** Unless otherwise noted, current CPS PreK students who do NOT attend their attendance area school must reapply through GoCPS if they wish to remain there for kindergarten.

Children's Engineering Program

Children's Engineering programs create an age appropriate learning experience focused on concepts of the engineering process. As part of the curriculum, children work together on engineering design challenges, projects, and activities. The engineering curriculum is interdisciplinary and incorporates reading, math, writing, communication, natural science, and technology.

One-Way Dual Language Program (Spanish/English)

One-way dual language programs provide instruction in two languages and are primarily intended to serve English Learners (ELs). Students receive core instruction (language arts, math, science, social science) through a second language with the goal of all students becoming bilingual and biliterate in both Spanish and English. Because one-way programs are designed with the needs of ELs in mind, selections for these programs will prioritize Spanish-speaking ELs. Applicants who do not speak Spanish may not be eligible to receive an offer to one-way programs. Please note that many Dual Language programs are phasing in and will add one grade level each year until all grade levels served by the school offer the program.

Two-Way Dual Language Program (Spanish/English)

Two-way dual language programs aim for a 50:50 balance of English Learners (ELs) and non-ELs in the classroom. Students serve as language models to each other as they acquire the second language. Like one-way programs, two-way dual language programs provide instruction in two languages. Students receive core instruction (language arts, math, science, social science) through a second language with the goal of all students becoming bilingual and biliterate in both Spanish and English. For students applying to grades 3 and above, Spanish proficiency is necessary for students to be successful in the program. Please note that many Dual Language programs are phasing in and will add one grade level each year until all grade levels served by the school offer the program.

Technology Program schools thoughtfully integrate technology and digital media throughout the curriculum to ensure that students develop the skills and habits of mind that will enable them to be successful in whatever endeavors they wish to pursue. This includes enabling students to use technology and digital media to demonstrate creative thinking and construct knowledge; communicate and work collaboratively; gather, evaluate and use information; conduct research, manage projects, and solve problems, practice legal and ethical behaviors while online; and understand technology concepts, systems, and operations.

SELECTIVE ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

Selective Enrollment Elementary Schools (SEES) provide instruction at an accelerated level. Students must take an admissions exam and meet minimum program eligibility requirements in order to be eligible to receive an offer from a SEES program. Tier is applied in the selections process for the entry year only. SEES programs do not offer sibling or staff preference.

Academic Centers

Academic Centers are housed in high schools and allow high-achieving students to take high school classes. Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA to be eligible to take the admissions exam. The Academic Center entrance exam is the Regional Gifted Center exam, which is a cognitive ability test that taps into the student's ability to form abstract concepts and solve problems using novel information. Students can earn a maximum of 600 total points: 300 points from the entrance exam, and 300 points from final grades from the previous school year. **Academic Center students can continue in the General Education program of their current school when they reach high school; they do NOT need to reapply for 9th grade.**
