Below is a list of the kinds of questions that are important to ask when designing a space for learning. Use these categories to organize your thoughts

<b>Design Principle</b>	<b>Ask yourself...</b>	<b>Notes</b>
 <b>Focus</b>	What is everyone paying attention to?	
 <b>Interaction</b>	How are we working together?	
 <b>Movement</b>	Is there enough room to move around?	
 <b>Access</b>	How do we get what we need?	
 <b>Visibility</b>	Can we see and hear what we need to see and hear?	
 <b>Flexibility</b>	Can we move stuff around?	
 <b>Choice</b>	Can we choose where we work?	
 <b>Style</b>	What do the colors and decorations say about the space?
